Curriculum is built on the basics:

- Core Stability - concepts to improve mobility, balance and explosiveness
- Footwork - The most important building block for successful keeping. We work on simple principles and exercises to perfect the dancing GKing athlete!
- Kicking - How to be controlled and consistent.
- Angles, stance and positioning in relation to the point and type of attack.
- Using foam effectively: Gloves, leg guards and kickers. They do more than just look pretty - or prevent pain.

- Second saves. Dealing with that next shot; Getting in position and snuffing out that danger.
- 1 v 1's
They occur all over the circle, upright and blocking on the ground. How and when to go to ground and what to do when you are down there.
- Getting up. When you're down, you're down? We'll show you the best way to pop back up quickly and efficiently.
- Communicating. Defenders need direction; what to say and when to say it.
- Penalty Corners. The GK's role and how to set up your defensive unit.
- Decision-making. When & how to use the right tools.
